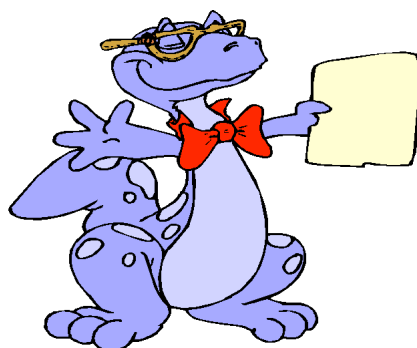

The Roynon Museum has an extensive collection of artifacts, fossils, and skeletal samples of prehistoric animals. There is a charge of **\$14 per child**, which includes a guided tour and the chance to build a take-home rock, mineral, or fossil kit and fill a small bag of polished rocks to keep.

Any additional adults will need to pay \$5.
