

Technology Curriculum Institute

Designing Technology-Rich Curriculum



This four-day institute will focus on developing technology-rich curriculum for EUSD classrooms. Use your knowledge of curriculum along with your expertise in integrating technology to design engaging and practical lessons you can do with your students.

EUSD technology staff will be guiding your work as you build your lessons or unit while collaborating with your colleagues. Technology integration will be a key feature of this institute. Additionally, we will provide opportunities for deepening your knowledge of the software we will be using.

You will be collaborating with other teachers in your grade range to create a lesson that uses software from iWork '08 (Numbers, Keynote, Pages) or iLife '06 (Garageband).

We are looking for teachers with good curriculum skills, collaboration skills, and at least **strong** knowledge of one of the iLife/iWork applications above. We want to be able get started right away creating lessons that will be able to be used by teachers all over our district. You need to be able to attend all four days of this institute.

The institute is scheduled for Monday, June 29th through Thursday, July 2nd, 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., with an unpaid hour for lunch. It will take place at the Carilyn Gilbert Education Center in the Board Room.

It is expected that you will be implementing this project in your classroom with your students in the first trimester of 2009-2010.

Those accepted to the institute will be paid hourly for their time. Due to unknown budget constraints, we are unable to say at this time how many teachers will be accepted into the institute.
