

Project LIVE 2009-2010

(Learning through Instructional Video in Education)



Note: New Project LIVE participants this year are funded largely by funds made available by the Escondido Education Foundation.

Teachers: We want you to be part of **Project LIVE**, a group of teachers dedicated to the idea that video can be a powerful learning tool for all students. **Project LIVE** will give you a chance to create meaningful, curriculum-centered videos with your students. If you are selected to be a part of **Project LIVE**, you will receive, pending available funding, for use in your classroom (and for your tenure in EUSD):

- A new Apple laptop
- A Digital Video Camcorder
- An external hard drive suitable for digital video
- An external microphone for high quality audio in your videos
- A lot of training in how to use all of the above
- Photoshop Elements
- Several instructional and reference books
- Office for OS X
- QuickTime Pro

In return, the following will be expected from you (check all dates to be certain you're available; **attendance at all is mandatory**):

- A minimum of three finished videos (1-5 minutes each) created during the 2009-2010 school year, at least one of which is to be entered in the iVIE Film Festival in May, 2010. All three videos are to address curriculum standards or classroom procedure. The iVIE submission must be a student-created video.
- Attendance at a two-day workshop (approx. 12 hours; scheduled for Friday, September 11 (3:30-7:30) and Saturday, 12 (8 am-4 pm)
- Attendance at monthly Project LIVE meetings [3:30-5:30] (October 5, November 16, December 7, January 11, February 8, March 8, April TBD, May TBD, June 7). **Attendance at all meetings is required.**
- Regular communication via your district email account

We will select as many participants as funding will allow (schools can fund additional participants, if they choose). Participants are expected to already be fairly comfortable working on a Macintosh. It will be helpful, but not essential, if you have some experience with video, especially iMovie.
