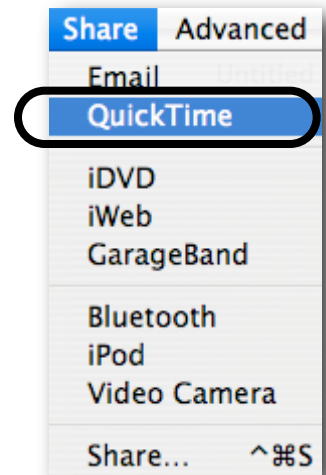
Compression Settings

This document will give you the details necessary to properly compress your video for submission to the EUSD ShowcaseEd server.

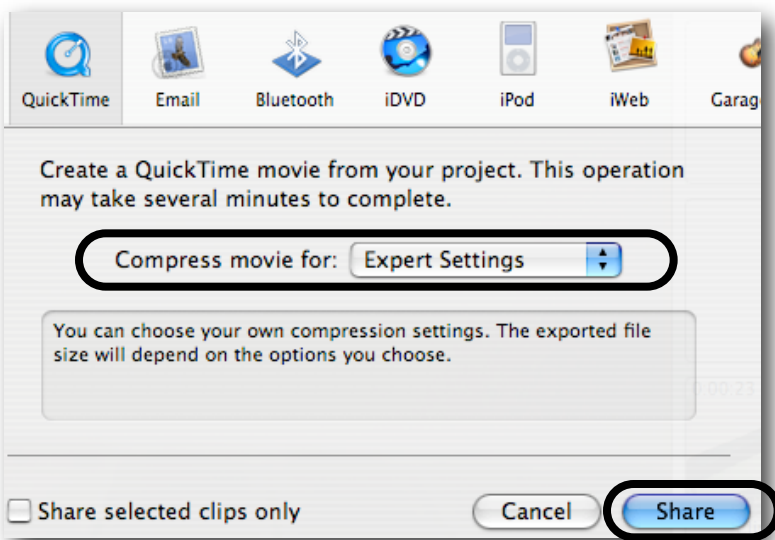
In its raw form, your movie is too large to upload (even with broadband, it could take hours!), so we need to use the tools built into your movie-editing software to create a smaller file that can be used for submission. (Make sure you have run all of the software updates).

If you are using iMovie:

1) Choose **Share** > **QuickTime**



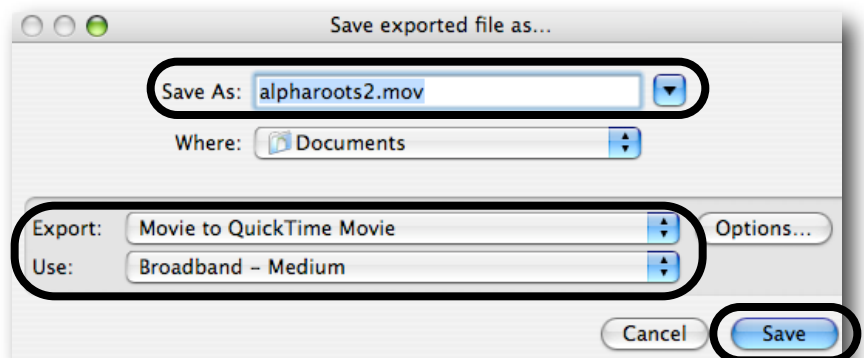
2) In the window that pops up, choose **Expert Settings** from the “Compress Movie for:” options. Then click the **Share** button:



3) Title your video

4) Select the presets **Movie to QuickTime Movie** and **Broadband Medium**.

5) Click **Save**.



If you are using Final Cut Pro:

1) Choose **File > Export > Using Quick-time Conversion**

2) Title your video and choose a location to store it. Select the preset **Broadband Medium** and the **Save**.

Once you have followed the steps above, use your web browser to get to your Team Page and follow the upload instructions to submit your movie. Make sure you are connected through a broadband internet connection (School, Cable Modem, or DSL). If you have a 56K dial-up connection the upload will not work.

NOTE: Before you upload, check the size of the file you created with your editing software. To do this, click once on the file to highlight it and go to **File > Get Info**. If your video file size is over 20MB then you have not compressed the video correctly.
